### Site Use & Campsite Appearance

---

#### Seasonal Sites

- Sites are sold on an annual basis for your own personal use and are not for rental purposes. If a trailer is found to be used for rental purposes, the seasonal family will be asked to haul out of the park.
- Family or friends may visit occasionally. For security reasons, please let management know who will be using your trailer.
- No baby barns may be used as sleeping quarters. No tents are allowed on lots for visitors.
- Sites must be kept clear of unsightly items. Please keep your campsite tidy and consider how it looks to your neighbours.

#### Campsite Boundaries

- Please do not cut through another site while walking around the campground. This is the same as walking across someone's front porch. Please take the long way around and respect other campers' space.

#### Trees

- Trees are not to be cut or damaged. If good trees must be cut, the site owner must be willing to purchase replacement red maple trees for the site.

### Structures, Storage & Parking

---

#### Building, Decks, Barns, Tool Sheds, Gravel, etc.

- Approval is required before constructing anything on your site. The campground's specific building regulations and sizes must be followed, and possible permits may need to be purchased.
- Barns will not be allowed larger than 8 x 10 on larger B sites. Small A sites are limited to 8 x 8 barns.
- Enclosed covered decks are only allowed on half the length of the trailer.

#### Boats & Trailers

- Boats are not allowed to be parked on your site. Sites are for camping trailers and vehicles. Small kayaks are permitted.
- Hauling trailers are only allowed for unloading and are not permitted for long-term parking.

#### Vehicles & Speed Limit

- Speed limit is 10 km/h or less.
- Dirt bikes, ATVs, golf carts, kids' electric cars and other non-road-legal vehicles are not permitted in the park unless needed for staff or property maintenance use.
- Electric bikes may be used in the park, but must follow bicycle rules and road speeds.
- Electric vehicles are not permitted to be charged at the campground. Management is considering a vehicle charging station in the future.

### Family, Pets & Safety

---

#### Supervision

- Parents are responsible for the supervision, safety and whereabouts of their children and visitors, and are liable for their actions.
- Use of the park, pool and playground equipment is at your own risk. Please ride bikes on roads with caution.
- For safety, children should have bikes off roads at dusk and should not be riding, walking or running through trailer sites. This is dangerous and can cause significant damage.

#### Pets

- Up to two pets are allowed only if they are leashed, cleaned up after and kept quiet.
- Please remember that people come here for peace and quiet, and some people are afraid of dogs.
- If your animal is a barker, management will request a bark collar. Pets are not allowed in buildings.

## Fire, Environment & General Courtesy

---

### Campfires & Fireworks

- Fire pits are not to be used for burning garbage.
- Fireworks are not permitted in the park at any time.
- Please see management for fire pit sizes and locations, and for fire ban information.

### Animal Feeding

- Please do not seed-feed birds or other critters. Liquid hummingbird feeders and bird baths are permitted.

### Neighbour Courtesy

- Please be considerate of your neighbours with parking, noise levels, campsite appearance and general conduct.

Please use common sense and consider your neighbours regarding parking and noise levels.
